The purpose of this Public Bulletin is to apprise the public of applications received from potential operators for a new Centralized Examination Station (CES) in the John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) environment and to invite comments thereon.

**BACKGROUND:**

On July 01, 2023, JFK issued a Public Bulletin 23-012-JFK announcing that applications for operating a CES would be accepted in accordance with the procedures set fourth in 19 CFR 118.2.

The 60-day “Open Season” for submission of applications ended on September 1, 2023. Pursuant to 19 CFR 118.12, the CBP Port Director is hereby advising the public of the applications received and inviting comments regarding the applications. Public comments must be received within 30 calendar days from the date of this notice.

**2. CBP, CBPa, REFRIGERATED & EXTRA HANDLING EXAMINATIONS FULL AIRLINE UNIT LOAD DEVICE (ULD):**

The airline industry utilizes (3) IATA refrigerated Unit Loading Devices (ULD). In addition, specialized IATA sanctioned ULD's are available for project cargo. The charge for handling CBP instructed refrigerated examinations at the CES is as follows:

- Non-pharmaceutical ULDs ..... \$0.22/kg
- Pharmaceutical ULDs ..... \$0.26/kg

**3. FACILITY CHARGE FOR FULL CONTAINER (FCL): \$250**

The facility charge will apply to full ULD examinations in addition to all the other examination charges. This charge covers the facility operational requirements and usage, manipulation of seized shipments, maintenance costs, in and out interchanges, security 24(7 /365 with access, yard handling, specialized equipment and cargo liability.

**4. SEIZURE/FORFEITURE FEE: \$25**

To cover costs of handling, storage and manipulation of seized shipments that are forfeited and destroyed with no proceeds available to cover the costs for which the CES services were provided. This fee applies only to full ULDs trade enforcement examinations excluding agriculture.

**5. TAILGATE EXAMINATIONS - \$100**

Non refrigerated cargo ULDs that have an examination and viewing of cargo at a dock door or tail end of a container only, with no unloading, will incur a tailgate fee of \$50. This fee is for all ULDs.

The tailgate examination fee is in addition to the facility fee for ULD loads.

**6. AIR FREIGHT ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE FEE:**

These charges are for all full and partial ULD transported from JFK to CES facilities.

The above charges will be paid plus an administrative fee of \$25.

**7. PICKUP FEE - \$325**

This is the cost associated with collecting a shipment from JFK to CES facility. This cost is per ULD container.

**8. TSA SECURITIES FEE - \$ AIRLINE CHARGE**

This TSA security charge is separate from the cargo screening fee.

Also, an administrative fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.

**9. HAZARDOUS MATERIAL FEE - \$ AIRLINE CHARGE**

If applicable, this fee is for the shipping and handling of hazardous materials and explosives.

Also, an administrative fee of \$25.00 will be assessed.



**10. MISCELLANEOUS FEES INCURRED:**

The charges below are unique to each air shipment and are utilized accordingly. These additional charges will be paid to the airlines for release of the ULD. Also, an administrative fee of \$25 will be assessed.

**ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES: Maximum \$50**

The administrative fee will not exceed \$50 per ULD.

**11. FREE TIME AND STORAGE ULD & PARTIAL “AFTER RELEASE”:**

FREE TIME: The day that we advise the trucker and the customs broker that a CBP or Government Examination is released, and the following day, are considered free time. Storage starts the day thereafter, or third day. If the last free day is Saturday, free time carries to the following Monday. If the last free day is Friday, storage starts on Saturday.

Storage after free time expires: (Third Day)

Full ULD Containers .....	\$75 Per Calendar Day
Less than container load (LCL) .....	\$50 Per Calendar Day

**12. “ON HOLD” HANDLING & STORAGE ON FULL ULD AND PARTIAL ULD:**

If we are required by CBP or a Government Agency to “HOLD” the shipment in the original container or in our warehouse after examination, the following fees apply.

Full ULD Containers .....	\$50 Per Day	
Storage (less container)(LCL) .....	\$.12/cft per day .....	\$50 Minimum
Handling (less container)(LCL) .....	\$.14/cft .....	\$50 Min./Mo.

**13. REFRIGERATED ULD INDOOR PLUGIN:**

- CES Facility will provide indoor power plugins to hold refrigerated cargo at required temperature.
- Charges are incurred 12 hours after release by CBP. Custom Broker or Agent must advise in writing instructions to “Hold” refrigerated cargo. The rate is \$3.75 per hour with a 10 (ten) minute grace period for pick up.
- Plug in charges will be calculated in hourly increments until out gated.
- Pick up of stored refrigerated product is during normal operating hours.

**14. TRANSLOADING OF CLEARED CBP ULD EXAMINATIONS:**

100% examinations consist of removing all cargo from the ULD(s) and returning the cargo to the same container(s). Customers who would like their goods loaded into different containers or trailers, for final delivery, may request this service before the cargo is reloaded into the original container(s). There will be no extra charge for this service providing the transload is done the same day as examination and the release by a Government Agency, except as listed below. Instructions for transloading and/or distribution must be in written form.

1. Separating for distribution, quoted upon request.
2. Transload performed on a different day than day of release by Government Agency, quoted upon request.

## **16. ADMINISTRATION/ ADVANCE FEE ON CHECK ADVANCES AT AIRLINE TERMINALS**

\$20 min or 5% of amount advanced.

## **17. COLLECTION FEE FOR THE ACCOUNT OF ULD DEPOSIT.**

The fee applies when Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. CES is held liable by an airline to collect per diem on their behalf from a third party trucker. This fee applies after Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. has brought the container to the Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. CES and another trucker picks up after CBP has cleared the cargo for trade.

This charge will not apply if the airline waives per diem until after CBP clearance and/or bills the CES pickup trucker or consignee direct for any per diem related to the container or chassis.

## **18. CARGO DAMAGE AND PER DIEM DISCLAIMER:**

Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. is not responsible for damage done to cargo or Unit Load Device (ULD) during inspection by a government agency. Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. is not responsible for any per diem charges on ULD received for examination, placed on hold, abandoned, sent to general order (GO) or seized by CBP or a Government Agency.

Damage noted on devanning of the ULD will immediately be conveyed to the Customs Broker via email and digital photography. A damage report will be created and all damage noted. There is no additional cost associated with this process.

If during the examination process, damage to cargo is noted, Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. will immediately alert the Customs Broker. An assessment of the situation will be made and an estimate of costs for reloading will be provided. If determined that the potential to cause additional damage may occur, the broker or importer will be notified to assist in the process. This will be done with permission from appropriate government agency after the ULD is released to the trade.

However, under no circumstances will Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. be held responsible for damaged cargo.

## **19. VOLUME INCENTIVE PROGRAM (VIP):**

Volume incentive program accommodates seasonal influx of large volumes of merchandise or produce over a defined season. The VIP discount applies only to examination rates. A VIP must exceed 150 ULDs in a qualifying single calendar season.

The 2% discount applies only to the examination rate.

The discount will be paid at the conclusion of the defined season after meeting the projected criteria.

Business to Customer (B2C) and Individual Packages will be calculated on either their actual weight or Dimensional (Volume) Weight, whichever tabulates out greater and billed accordingly. This also known as the Dim Factor.

### **Dim Factor (Dimensional Weight Factor)**

The DIM Factor is calculated by a mathematical equation used to determine the dimensional weight of an object. This equation is standard within the shipping industry. DIM Factor represents the volume of a shipment allowed per unit of weight. It is important because all cargo space involved in shipping goods has physical limits based on volume of the cargo and weight. We have recognized these variables and have allocated a volume per weight standard in our billing to capture cargo of light density.

### **How The Dim Factor is Calculated**

Length (L) x Width (W) x Height (H)  
Dim Factor

Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. will utilize the following Dim Factor.

### **International Shipments: 166 Dim Factor**

The system will either round down if the fraction of a pound (lb.) is less than 0.49 (<0.49) or round up if the fraction is 0.50 or greater (>0.50).

The resulting Dimensional Weight Factor will be compared against the actual weight of the package and the greater of the two, in pound(s), will be billed according to the tables indicating “Shipments in All Other Packaging/Maximum Weight in Lbs.” and its corresponding “Package Rate for Inspection”.

This charge covers the facility operational requirements and usage, manipulation of seized shipments, maintenance costs, in and out interchanges, security 24/7 /365 with access, yard handling, specialized equipment, and cargo liability.

**4. PICK UP FEE: \$/lb**

This is the cost associated with collecting a package from JFK to the CES facility. The base package pick up rate is \$4.00 up to and including 5 lbs. Thereafter the base rate plus \$0.07 per pound applies to all packages.

**5. FREE TIME AND STORAGE (FCL) & (LCL) “AFTER RELEASE”:**

FREE TIME: The day that we advise the trucker and the customs broker that a CBP or Government Examination is released, and the following day, are considered free time. Storage starts the day thereafter, or the third day. If the last free day is Saturday, free time carries to the following Monday. If the last free day is Friday, storage starts on Saturday.

Worldwide Flight Services, Inc. is not responsible for any per diem charges on containers received for examination, placed on hold, abandoned, sent to general order (GO), or seized by CBP or a Government Agency.

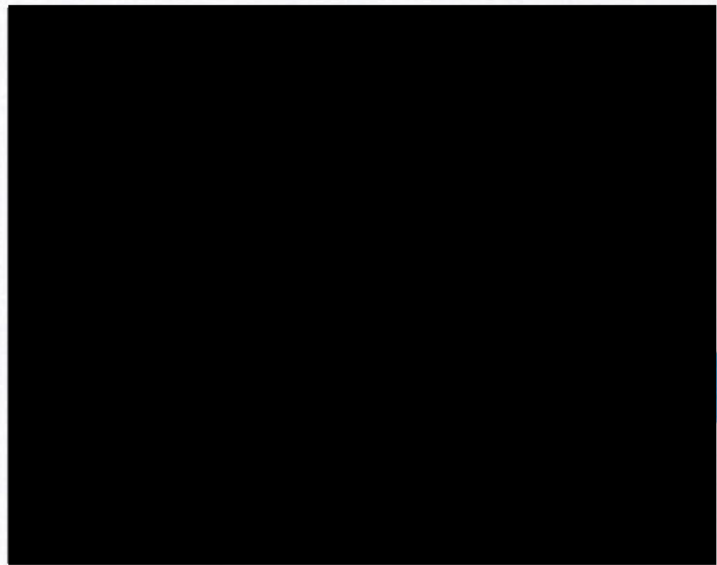
Damage noted on devanning of the container will immediately be conveyed to the Customs Broker via email and digital photography. A damage report will be created and all damage noted. There is no additional cost associated with this process.

If during the examination process, damage to cargo is noted, Worldwide Flight Service, Inc. will immediately alert the Customs Broker. An assessment of the situation will be made and an estimate of costs for reloading will be provided. If determined that the potential to cause additional damage may occur, the broker or importer will be notified to assist in the process. This will be done with permission from appropriate Government Agency after the container is released to the trade.

**4. All Employees with involvement in CES Operation**

We will not consider the use of temporary employees for normal operations; however, we are well-equipped to pull from within WFS for TDY assignments if necessary to ensure the proper operation of the facility during peak demand periods.

All employees deployed to the CES will undergo the appropriate CBP and Port Authority background checks prior to the start of their service, and WFS will submit a CF3078 for all personnel introduced to the facility.

**ADDITIONAL CHARGES**

Automobile surcharge - \$125.00 per vehicle.

Cargo requiring special handling needs will be assessed a fee of \$70.00 per hour.

Any per diem fees on Airline equipment will be invoiced at cost + 20% if the CES is held responsible for these fees and rebilled to the account of exam payment.

H&M does not add surcharges or overtime fee's for extended hours of operation to accommodate increased or seasonal volumes, however should H&M have the need to request of CBP additional Officer hours under the 599 reimbursable agreement to maintain fluid turn-times for our clients these fees will be equally dispersed over examination cargoes affected by the additional costs plus any expenses incurred by H&M International Warehousing.

Additional hours outside the normal CES hours made at the request of the client will incur a \$70.00 per man hour labor surcharge (4-hr. minimum).

Saturday, Sunday and Holiday facility openings made at request of CBP or for the need of processing additional and seasonal volume will not incur additional fees however if at the special request of a client outside of the above state a \$725 Terminal surcharge will be applicable.

Shipments requiring the use of special labor (i.e. mechanics, welders, etc.) and/or equipment outside the scope of normal cargo handling may incur additional fees which will be in line with industry standards and quoted per job as required.

Shipments requiring the administration of collection, payment or monitoring of Airline and/or GHA fees, freight releases and/or liens will be assessed a processing fee of \$35.00 per AWB/HAWB.

Reimbursable Services Fee's – equally divided among units for the date of required service with a \$25.00 minimum fee per shipment.

Disposal Fee – Man hour rate, cost of disposal + 20%.

Terminal Requirement Fee – This pass-through charge will be applied for any outstanding terminal charges required to be paid in order to pick up a container at the terminal. The charge will be based on the specific amount determined by the terminal. (Examples include paying terminal drayage, pop and tap inspection fees, etc.).

Cargo not examined at the CES but processed for seizure will incur a \$35.00 per carton seizure fee.

During the examination process, when we notice damaged cargo or believe that reloading may cause damage, we may notify the broker or importer (with permission from appropriate government agency) to view and/or supervise the claims or reloading process after release from examination. **1) Trucking:** The fees charged by Apex to pick up and deliver goods to CES from an airline, importer, CFS, bonded warehouse or FTZ will depend on the distance of the pickup location to the CES. This fee will apply to consolidated loads/pickups in addition to Fuel Surcharge (FSC), based on Department of Energy weekly fuel price and toll if applicable (at cost). The FSC may fluctuate and will affect total cost.

These fees cover the facility operational requirements and usage, manipulation of seized shipments, maintenance costs, warehouse in and warehouse out interchanges, security 24/7/365 with access, yard handling, specialized equipment and cargo liability. Examination fees are on a graduated scale depending on the number of packages designated for exam per house bills of B2C shipments per MAWB.

This is a flat fee of \$150 per master bill.

**7) Seizure and Forfeiture Fee:** To cover the costs of handling, storage and manipulation of seized shipments that are forfeited and destroyed with no proceeds available to cover costs for which CES. services were provided. The following rates will apply.

- B2B \$125.00 per Master Airway Bill
- B2C \$125.00 per Master Airway Bill associated to HAWB's of 1,500 or more packages per consolidation.  
B2C \$25 per HAWB for De-Minimis consolidations less than 1,500 HAWB's

**8) Tailgate Examinations:**

Non refrigerated cargo on ULDs that have an examination and viewing of cargo at a dock door or tail end of a ULD only, with no unloading, will incur a tailgate exam fee of \$100. The tailgate examination fee is in addition to the facility fee for ULD loads.

**9) Free time and storage ULD & partial ULD after CBP Release**

**FREE TIME:** The day that we advise the trucker and the customs broker that a CBP or Government Examination is released, and the following day, are considered free time. Storage starts the day thereafter, or third day. If the last free day is Saturday, free time carries to the following Monday. If the last free day is Friday, storage starts on Saturday. Storage AFTER FREE TIME EXPIRES (THIRD DAY):

There will be no extra charge for this service providing the transload is done the same day as examination and the release by a Government Agency, except as listed below. Instructions for transloading and/or distribution must be in written form.

1. Separating for distribution, quoted upon request.
2. Transload performed on a different day than day of release by Government Agency, quoted upon request.

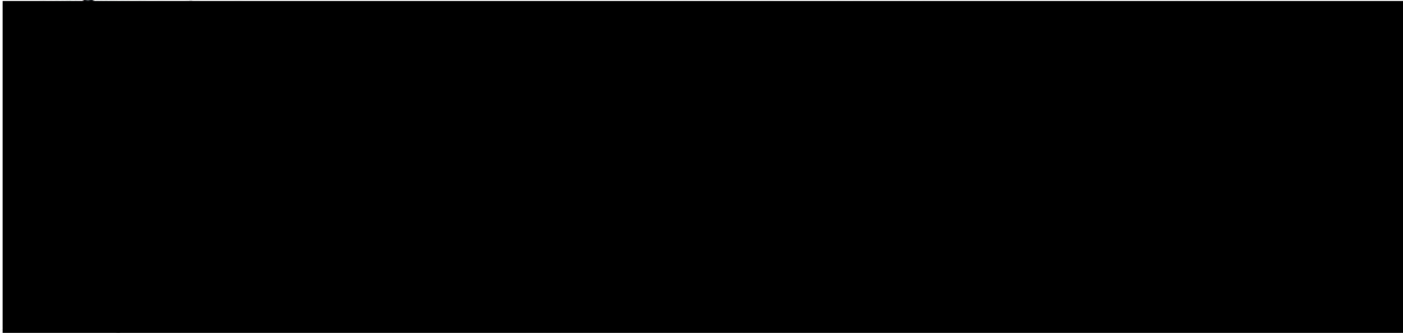
### **15) Payment Terms**
